On the second Saturday of May every year, Scouts and their families all around the world head out on a trail for a hike. This year Churchward Park will be heading by boat to walk a 10km section of the Queen Charlotte Track, between Resolution Bay, and Endeavour Inlet.

This walk is described as "Our most popular Cruise & Walk option - this gentle walk traverses native forest over a low saddle offering a spectacular vantage point for the photographer."

We would like to invite any Cub or Scouts to join us, and to bring your family and friends. You can even earn the badge pictured above! Scouts will have no problems completing this walk, Cubs will require the support of an adult.

Meet 8:30am at the Cougar Line office on the Main Town Wharf, Picton. We will travel by boat to the start of the walk, then by boat again from the end of the walk, back to Picton. You will need to bring a packed lunch, a drink bottle, walking shoes, warm clothes and a jacket.
